

Private jets are welcome to land at the local airport, Samedan, or arrive via the Zurich and Milan airports, which are both less than a three hour drive away.

We also offer a complimentary transfer to and from Pontresina station and Samedan Station via the hotel's limousine. For larger groups, we can also organise a transfer by bus with a local transportation company.






Take on friends and colleagues at the Grand Hotel Kronenhof's historic bowling alley while enjoying a traditional Swiss fondue or raclette.

# Outdoor activities


## BOB TAXI RIDE

Professional mountain guide Gian Luck takes you climbing on vertical ice with crampons and ice picks in unique canyons.



## GLACIER TREKKING

Try high altitude walking in crampons to test your stamina across the beautiful Bernina Range, Diavolezza–Morteratsch Glacier or Cambrena Brüche.

## SKIING

Day or night, skiing in the Engadin offers an unmatched experience across four diverse ski regions. Enjoy culinary delights and ski slopes at elevations over 3,303 metres above sea level.



## NATURAL ICE TRAIL

Follow the natural ice trail along the river Inn and through a magnificent meadow landscape. Enjoy the play of light on the river, the view of historic village centres and the tranquillity of the valley.

## E-MOUNTAIN BIKE

Explore the beauty of the Engadin by e-bike. Ride along mountain lakes, through pine forests and into remote side valleys. The trails offer stunning mountain views at every turn.

## ICE BATHING

Embrace your own nature, diving into a refreshing mountain lake nearby Grand Hotel Kronenhof or hidden away in a secret forest lake, with professional supervision.

## FREE FALL

Get a glimpse of the steepest start of a men's downhill ski race, featuring a 100% grade. The start is accessible by cable car, but is only recommended for those not afraid of heights.

## ALPINE SAILING

Participate in an exciting sailing regatta on the crystal-clear mountain lakes and enjoy unique views of St. Moritz and the surrounding mountains.



## Cultural Delights

### WHISKEY TASTING

Visit the world's highest (3,303 metres) whiskey distillery on Engadin's Corvatsch Peak via mountain cable car. Take a guided taste tour and become a whiskey lover.

### CHEESE MAKING

Discover firsthand how alpine cheese is made as an Alpine master prepares various cheeses over an open fire.

### MOUNTAIN BREAKFAST À DISCRÉTION

Enjoy an authentic mountain breakfast amidst pristine nature with a cheese buffet, fresh smoked Ziger, yoghurt, jam, fruit, various breads, smoked salsiz and other specialties.

### CAMERA OBSCURA

On the Bernina Pass, a Camera Obscura has been set up, offering visitors a unique way to experience the region's majestic peaks, encouraging reflection on the nature of perception.



### PRIVATE MUSEUM TOURS

Visit the renowned Segantini Museum, which was built by Engadin architect Nicolaus Hartmann (1880-1956) as a memorial for the world-famous painter Giovanni Segantini.

### LARET MARKET

Discover local tradition, hand-painted toys, raclette bread with silver onions, bratwurst with mustard, gypsy skewers, home-baked cakes, waffles and many other delicacies in Pontresina.

### GOAT TREKKING

Book trekking tours with these friendly animals. There's nothing like hiking through the Upper Engadin in the company of goats.





## Bespoke itineraries *designed to your interests*

We can create a variety of amazing itineraries centred around outdoor activities, artisanal delights or cultural adventures for you and your guests. Here are just a few of the many options available.

### DISCOVER THE ART OF PHOTOGRAPHY

Start your day with a delicious mountain breakfast, followed by a ride on the UNESCO World Heritage Bernina Express through the Engadin Valley to Bernina Pass for a guided tour of the Camera Obscura art project with local artist Daniel Meuli. Then board another train to Alp Grüm for lunch at Bellavista Restaurant before travelling back on the Bernina Express to Pontresina.

### THE GLACIER EXPERIENCE

The day starts with a walk to the nearby scenic mountain breakfast at Alp Schaukäserei Morteratsch. Then a delicious lesson on Swiss cheese making at a local cheese dairy, before another train ride to Diavolezza to ride the cable car to the mountain peak 3,000 metres above sea level. Lastly, enjoy hiking across a glacier trail to a high altitude lunch.

### A DAY IN PRISTINE NATURE

Take part in a short, picturesque morning hike from Grand Hotel Kronenhof to Restaurant Lej da Staz for brunch, followed by a dip in Stazersee Lake if you're feeling brave. Then enjoy a short scenic hike where you can try to blow an alphorn. Lastly, engage in a spot of competitive sailing with professional guides on the magnificently beautiful Lake St. Moritz – the winner gets a prize.
