COMO Le Beauvallon is one of the last hidden gems of the Riviera – a striking Belle Époque palace first opened in 1914. Steeped in history and imbued with the essence of the Côte d'Azur lifestyle, the property spans 10 acres of terraces and gardens shaded by palms and umbrella pines, with a 25-metre pool and a private pontoon for yacht tenders.

COMO Le Beauvallon's sea-view restaurant, Beauvallon Sur Mer, is the ideal setting for summer lunches and elegant evenings. Extending the restaurant's Riviera spirit, the beach club occupies an exclusive stretch of sand overlooking the Gulf of Saint-Tropez, with a stylish poolside, striking sunbeds, and a fresh, seasonal menu.

The sunlit Winter Garden conservatory serves all-day menus and healthful options from COMO Shambhala Kitchen, while the intimate bar and lounge, complete with outdoor terrace, evokes the timeless glamour of the Riviera.









## History of COMO Le Beauvallon


COMO Le Beauvallon opened its doors in 1914 as Le Golf Hôtel, a 100-room Belle Époque palace designed by Swiss architect Julien Flengenheimer, and commissioned by the Bernheim brothers, German émigrés who set up a distillery business in the United States.

The palace was requisitioned by the French government as a military hospital during the two World Wars, each time resuming its original luxurious purpose after a complete renovation.

The hotel became a place to see and be seen – a beloved Riviera retreat for creatives, duchesses and Hollywood stars alike. Authors Colette and F. Scott Fitzgerald stayed, as did Winston Churchill and the French poet Paul Géraldy. In the 1960s, Le Beauvallon was the backdrop for both *Two for the Road*, starring Audrey Hepburn, and the cult series *The Troops of Saint-Tropez*.

After nearly two decades as an exclusive-use events venue, COMO Le Beauvallon reopened its doors to hotel guests in 2025, ushering a revived era of glamour for this Côte d'Azur icon.

- **10 Beauvallon Suites** (50 to 55 sqm): Elegant and light-filled, these one-bedroom suites offer connecting options and plush king-size beds.












### Accommodation











